## Former President and PM Might Face Charges Vis Alleged CIA Prisons in Poland

Prosecutors running the investigation into alleged CIA prisons in Poland are considering bringing charges against the highest-rank Polish state officials for complicity in war crimes, the daily Gazeta Wyborcza said citing its own findings.

Such accusation might result in bringing the politicians before the State Tribunal.

As the investigation concerns the years 2002-2005, the officials in question are the then President Aleksander Kwasniewski, PM Leszek Miller and Internal Minister Krzysztof Janik.

Kwasniewski says that he has not been examined by the prosecution. He admits that CIA landed at the Polish airport in Szymany but no prisons were run.

Miller claims he has nothing to say on the issue though he earlier claimed no secret CIA prisons existed in Poland, the daily says.

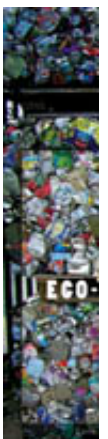
